

Donations for 2011 Japanese Earthquake/Tsunami

On Friday 11th March 2011, Japan was hit by 9.0 magnitude earthquake which generated a powerful tsunami in the coastal areas of North Eastern Japan. The epicenter of the quake was approximately 72km east of the Oshika Peninsula and the hypocentre was approximately at an underwater depth of 32km. The earthquake also damaged reactors at Fukushima Nuclear Plant, and the Japanese authorities are still grappling to bring radiation leakages at the plant under control.

The tsunami annihilated coastal towns near the epicentre of the earthquake in North East Japan and left trails of devastation destroying houses, factories and leaving thousands of people homeless, missing or killed. Approximately 28,000 people are reported to have either been killed or missing.

We stand firm in support of the people of Japan as they try to recover from the triple effect of the earthquake, tsunami and nuclear situation.
